codigodeactivaciondewondersharedrfonegratis A: The IPv6 section of the link hints that it is related to Facebook, which is possible because Facebook's IPv6 tunneling protocol is often used to send outbound traffic over IPv6 for most sites. The link you provided is possible because it is most likely using a tunneling protocol. The protocol is called SOCKS and tunneling allows these kind of protocols to hide the traffic originating from IPv6 from a traditional firewall. It may still be possible for a firewall to block access to a website using that tunnel, but even with the cloak it is worth trying as it might be easier than an IP address. This is for Comcast in case you want to disable their IPv6 tunneling on your side. You will need to configure your router to manually enable IPv6 routing so that it routes traffic through the tunnel from the Comcast site to your computer. Then your firewall should be able to allow these packets through. A: This is because of Facebook. IPv6 was used. It's a network tunnel.
